### Meet our new president TERRENCE MICHAEL “MIKE” PEARSON

President Terrence Michael “Mike” Pearson is the second generation of his family to be born in the Philippines. His grandfather came to Baguio in the early 1903’s as a gold mining engineer, his mother was born at the old Norte Dame Hospital here in Baguio and his uncle was born in Camp (Holmes) Dangwa during World War II.

Pres. Mike grew up in the Balatoc Mines (both his mother and grandfather worked for the same company—where he learned his Ilocano) until he was 12 years old. He started at Chinese Patriotic School before moving on to Brent School and eventually to San Agustin in Manila. His high school and university education were in Hamilton, New Zealand; he eventually made the New Zealand secondary and junior teams for basketball, badminton and field hockey.

After a brief stint working with his mother at Batong Buhay Mines in Kalinga, Mike left for the United States to work for Pepsi-Cola in Denver, Colorado. A Year later, he was back in Baguio and began working on a number of different businesses—antique buying/selling, running a handicrafts store, interior design, RTW export designing (sweaters) as well as several trading companies involved in various endeavors.

In 1985, Brent School asked Pres. Mike to come and work for a year to straighten out the boarding and school activities department, as he had the experience in living as a boarder in a high school in New Zealand. Arranging his business matters to allow this, Mike never realized that the “one year” would turn into 10 years of working at the school (!). Both his mother and uncle had graduated at Brent, his grandmother and mother taught at Brent and now he seemed to be following in their footsteps.

In 1990, after two courtships with the same woman (it’s a long story...), he married Mina Estella (his best friend’s youngest sister) in the Brent Chapel. The still lived on campus and in 1993, Matthew Benjamin became the first of three Pearson siblings. In 1995, the Pearson family left Brent to go back into the business world and Katherine Mary “Kimmy” Pearson was born that same year. Their first business was a convenience store (TOSS) at the Nevada Square and when that was up and running, Pres. Mike agreed to enter the Estella family business and set-up the northern Luzon regional office of Olympia Philippines, Inc. here in Baguio.

Pres. Mike has been with Olympia since 1996, expanding the operations to include the Cagayan Valley and all of Central Luzon. Currently, the regional office handles all the Olympia product line, is the HP Service Center for Baguio and Benguet, the service center for *In Focus* projectors and represents Siemens Philippines in a number of endeavors. The Pearsons also now own the Mongkok Express franchise in SM Baguio, which is run by Mina.

As well as this, Pres. Mike has at various times been the president of the local basketball league, the mountain bikers association; a champion bowler, he was/is also a member of both the Baguio Country Club and Camp John Hay golf teams.

After 3 or 4 years of constantly hearing (pressuring) about what RC Baguio was up to from PP Rene Ronquillo, Pres. Mike joined the club in August of 1998—the year of PP Rene’s presidency. Having joined Rotary previously with Baguio North in the 80’s, it was a case of “balik-Rotary” for the Pearson family. In 2001, Gabrielle Mara “Gabbie” Pearson was born to complete the family-Pearson.

Pres. Mike was elected to the Board of Directors in 1998 and had been a member of the Board until 2003-04 when he decided to take a year off, having already served for four years and two vice-presidencies, as well as having been Club Secretary in Pres. Alfred’s term. Pres. Mike’s work in the club has been mostly to do with the financial and organizational side—chairman of the Ways and Means, as well as Editor of Canao.

Rotary will be this year’s biggest challenge for Pres. Mike—something he has already committed to.

# OUR PROGRAMME MODUS OPERANDI FOR THIS YEAR



## Programme Participation Guidelines

PP Caloy Mendoza

To see to it that the club can adjourn at/about 2 P.M., the following are suggested to be adhered to :

1. Prepare for your part. Prepare to fail if you do not prepare.
2. Anyone who can not make it as scheduled, for a reasonable cause, must notify the Program Coordinator at least week in advance.
3. The Program Coordinator must communicate with those listed to assist him during the day. If one can not make it, contact the Rotarian scheduled for the same role the following week or weeks and see if their schedule can be exchanged.
4. The Program Coordinator must try his/her best to make those in the program follow their allotted time schedule.
5. As a rejoinder :
  - a. Let us try our best to give the GHS more time by sticking to our own time allotments
  - b. Entertainment should not eat up too much of the time. Let us try to limit this to only 10 minutes.
  - c. The Introduction of Visiting Rotarians and Guests should be done the Rotary Way. Variations may be made to liven up this number. However, it should always be done following Rotary Protocol.
  - d. The Fine Master need not fine every member. The accepted rule is to consider the Fine Moments as a Time for Recognition of good deeds done during the week. Thus, there is really a need to communicate with others to find out who must be recognized, what has to be recognized, and possibly how much one is willing to share. The time for this should not exceed 15 minutes.
  - e. Try to limit the Members' Time to important announcements only.
  - f. Prepare in advance the tone or direction of the Introduction of the Guest of Honor and Speaker. Sometimes it is better to concentrate on what has not been printed in our Cañao. This is to give the GHS the time needed to deliver his/her message and to entertain questions in the Open Forum.
  - g. The Program Coordinator should give different members a chance to ask a question during the open forum.
  - h. The Response should be that of the Club by the designated member. Let us try not to veer away from this.

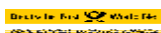

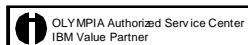
