Last weekend was a fully-loaded and hectic weekend for your president: seven Rotary activities over a span of three days. In my book, one of the busiest we ever had.

Friday, 14 September 07 was for two meetings. A Special Cluster 1C meeting was held at Jesnor Building with AG Dan Torres started at 5PM. We took up concerns such as the “Rotary Hour” proposed as a weekly activity for all Baguio-Benguet Rotary clubs; starting with a Presidents’ Hour come 03 October 07. Each club based on age—on a rotation basis will be assigned per week. Being the oldest in the district, we will go first on 10 October 07, then be on again after eight weeks.

We had to leave the Cluster meeting at 6:30PM to prepare for our third RCB Regular Board Meeting at the Baguio Palace Hotel. Our meeting was called to order at 7PM sharp. We finished around 9:30PM. You will be furnished the minutes of the meeting as soon as it is ready.

Saturday, 15 September 07 was for four separate activities. We left Baguio at 6:45AM. In Dagupan Star Plaza Hotel, we attended the opening of the Rotary Community Corps (RCC) Seminar in the main ballroom at the sixth floor of the hotel. PN Bert was assigned to join our two representatives from our Luding RCC; so he had to stay behind and represent RCB at that venue and forum.

Right after that, we joined Gov. Owens and PDG Alvin as they transferred to the District Leadership Seminar- venue at the ground floor of the (same) hotel. The opening was relatively brief, with the Overview being given by District Trainer PDG Alvin Gonzales. The first speaker was DGN Oyan Villanueva talking about the topic of “Leadership Opportunities.” Promptly thereafter was lunch; but we had to leave for Baguio as the buffet was being partaken off. We were on-site at around 8:30AM; joined by our SLU and UB Rotaractors and a number of our RCB doctors (including Dr. Doming Valencia). It was after 1:30PM when we were done. A worthy capping activity for a great Rotary week.

He focused his discussion on the Electric Power Industry Reform Act (EPIRA) or RA 9136 specifically on the unbundled rate components such as : the generation charges, transmission charges, system loss charges, distribution charges, lifeline rate subsidy, interclass cross subsidy charges, power rate reduction due to loan condonation; power rate reduction in all residential and customers; as mandated by RA 9136; universal charges; and the effect of the value added tax, and its components.

Director Cecille delivered the Response. She gracefully thanked our Guest of Honor and Speaker for the enlightenment on the various components of the electric bill that the consumer pays monthly. Indeed, it was very educational to the members. A Plaque of Appreciation was presented to our Guest Speaker for sharing valuable time with the club.

The meeting was adjourned after the singing of the “Pilipinas Kong Mahal”.

### EVENT SYNOPSIS

The first RCB Medical Mission was held at Tadiangan, Tuba Benguet at the St. Joseph, Baptist Church. The starting point was at Baguio Achievers' Academy at 7:00AM and we arrived at Tadiangan around 8:00AM. We had a good number of participants: eleven RCB members, two Rotary Anns, 4 Rotakids, and eleven Rotaractors covering the Pharmacy, Dental, and Medical. As soon as we arrived there were already patients waiting so we started right away especially the kids for circumcision, we did not give them a chance to change their minds. The Medical Mission at Tadiangan ended at 1:30PM successfully and satisfying that we were able to treat: Medical Adult-74, Pedia-59; Surgical-22 and Dental-55.

## FEATURE: THE MAKING OF A ROTARIAN

*This Editorial was published in the Cañao in 1966 by the late PP “Abe” Abellera, noted writer and doctor in the city. As food for thought, a couple of his writings were published in the R.I. magazine, “The Rotarian” during his time, that is, according to the archives of RCB.*

Some years ago, a Rotarian got involved with what can easily be identified as a magnificent obsession. He seemed to have been engulfed into that kind of loneliness that can only find relief in a man’s success to pull out of himself, the imprisoned longings to be useful to others. So, he sought the association of fellows like him, but of different vocation, hoping that interaction with kind may present him the key to unlock the drive seeking expression. He got a pal, a friend and then another and very soon they got infected with the splendid malady he bore.

The WHEEL rolled and the germ of Rotary spread to all corners of the globe. Men who are constitutionally disposed to contagion succumbed to the disease with ease and enthusiasm. Rotary was born and generations of Rotarians joined the burst of population explosion in it. Yes, some years ago a Rotarian conceived the birth of Rotary and today makes the Rotarian.

What factors and processes make a man a Rotarian? They say that without socialization, a man does not become a human. And they say that a Rotarian is a more special kind of a human being. It is not enough for him to abide by rules and prohibitions to make a social living go on smoothly. He would also go beyond requirements to further better living. Respect for fellowmen, love for the world, good will and understanding are traits he possess that makes him avid in his devotion to service. He reads about these in books and hears them in preachings, but they become part of him only through fellowship in rotary meetings and rotary inter-personal relations. So, Rotarians dine together, sing together and think together every week. In this way they continue to cultivate the traits that shape the Rotarians in the making. Then, the thoroughbred Rotarian takes to his home, to his wife and children the attitudes and values that have become part of his very sinews. A Rotarian once made, continues to be made. To him, genesis is never ended. He does not remain Rotarian alone. His whole family becoming Rotarian, continues to his ever becoming one.

In its ideal sense, Rotary is like a cult. Its influences on the man are as effective as the effects of one’s religion on attitudes and behavior. Thus the Rotarian is made as the making of a good man through beliefs and principles that he regards best in life. The Rotary WHEEL looks small but its roundness enables it to traverse the whole globe to make one Rotarian and one mankind.
