Three communities were the beneficiaries of the computers: One to Luding, Nine to the Elementary School of Poyopoy, and Ten to the Elementary School of Taloy Sur, Tuba, Benguet. On Saturday, February 2nd IPP Gerard and PP Bob delivered 10 computers to the school of deaf, SPED Deaf. IPP Gerard was taken back by the emotions of the students when they saw the computers. They had tears in their eyes expressing their happiness and thanked the Rotary Clubs (Baguio, Sunrise, and Clare) there present profusely.

Today, we rely heavily with the use of the computer to communicate, research, and conduct our business. 


