

Rotary Club of Baguio in the City's History

There was a time when Rotary frowned on publishing its achievements because it was not in good taste to congratulate oneself for worthwhile activities. Service to community and humanity is reward itself. In these times of advanced technology however, especially in information technology, it is imperative for Rotary to inform all and sundry the very reason for its existence which is "Service above self"

The Rotary Club of Baguio, in particular has always been a premier civic organization in the City of Baguio. It was founded on November 27, 1937, and the formal organization ceremony was witnessed by Manila Rotarians led by Justice



George A. Malcolm, then president of the Rotary Club of Manila which sponsored the new Club. The charter members were 35 Baguio residents (15 Filipinos, 18 Americans and 2 Japanese). The Charter President was Col. Louis J. Van Schaick, Vice President was then City Mayor Sergio Bayan, Secretary was John Woodson, Treasurer was John Omalley, and the Sergeant at Arms was Ed B. Mullaney. Its Charter was approved by the Rotary International on February 21, 1938 and was presented to Pres. Louis J. Van Schaick by Dr. Carlos P. Romulo on April 18, 1938.

Rotary Club of Baguio (RCB), the 4,587th member of Rotary International and the oldest club organized North of Manila; the 6th Rotary Club in the Philippines has produced 3 District Governors (PDG Nanding Manalo, PDG Ikong Reyes, & PDG Carling Santiago), 58 Paul Harris Fellows, and 5 daughter Rotary Clubs. It has hosted the District Conference 8 times.

The Rotary Club of Baguio has four avenues of service; club service, vocational service, community service and international service. Under community service it has been a staunch partner not only of the City but also of its suburbs. Projects which Rotary Club of Baguio Presidents regularly consider as standard and ordinary are *Medical, Dental, & Legal* outreach programs to different barangays in and outside the city. These include free circumcision, free operation for financially handicapped children with cleft lip and cleft palette, blood typing and bloodletting of donors, feeding programs, polio vaccination, vitamin "A" supplement.

Trees are routinely planted at the City's Busol watershed and other sites like the Philippine Military compound and other parks. Common projects are scholarships like: the defunct American Field Service Program; more lately and still existing, the Baguio Scholarship Foundation a WCS project funded by Japanese Rotary Clubs for deserving students to different schools in the City; and, donation of books to the Baguio City High School and other schools and libraries. The Rotary Club of Baguio usually conducts Career Guidance seminars for high school students.

The Rotary Club of Baguio is very proud to mention numerous notable programs that include:

- adoption of pre-school class at Irisan;
- establishment of pre-school class at the Department of Social Welfare;
- valuable assistance to the Diocesan Adult Center,
- assistance to out-of-school youth;
- aid to the Special Education Center, an educational institution for handicapped children;
- construction of toilets in Banangan Elementary School, Kennog Sablan, and Dalupirip elementary schools and other public parks.

Among its rare but very significant achievements were:

- a Goat Farm where the youth can work and earn enough to pay for their schooling (unfortunately this did not last long for lack of a suitable pasture land);
- playground equipments installed in Burnham Park;
- establishment of park and playground at Quezon Elementary School, at Dalupirip, and at other elementary schools in the city;
- 20 cement benches in Burnham Park;
- the construction of the imposing pylon and fountain near the Baguio General Hospital compound;
- donation of basketball court, equipment and all to the City of Baguio;
- donation of umbrella type street lights at the head of Session Road (this has since been replaced);
- construction of Police substation at Naguilian Road;
- renovation and expansion of Police substation at Pacdal Circle;
- donation of the kitchen annex of the Good Shepherd Convent;
- construction of tramline for farmers' use in transporting their products at Banengbeng, Sablan;
 and,
- donation of very expensive Braille embossers to St Louis University.

The Rotary Club of Baguio also launched the following ambitious but worthwhile projects

- the setting up of a Rotary Village Corps in Sablan;
- assistance to the community of Luding, Tuba:
 - o where micro-financing was introduced,
 - o roads were concreted; and
 - o sewing machines and other equipments were donated to help the underprivileged in their means of livelihood.

The Rotary Club of Baguio can be depended upon during times of disaster and other critical times. The club raised funds to help its members who were concentrated by the Japanese in Camp Holmes during World War II; for the flood victims of the City Camp Lagoon before the clearing of the drainage was perfected; and for the victims of the eruption of Mt. Pinatubo where relief goods were distributed.

Even if no mention was made under whose presidency these projects were undertaken, all 66 presidents past and present can stand proud of these achievements, and because every Rotary activity is a team effort, every president in one way or another has contributed to the success of the Rotary brotherhood. Add the ingredient of fellowship to the service rendered and life in Rotary becomes almost happily perfect. The joy of service is the lifeblood of Rotary's existence.

Rotary Awardees



PAST PRESIDENT JOHNNY ZARATE

Rotary Club of Baguio is lucky for having a member like PP Johnny Zarate. PP Johnny is the oldest member of the Club. He came after his father, who, was likewise, an active member of the Rotary Club of Baguio. PP Johnny joined Rotary in 5 November 1960. He was described to be a systematic worker making it a point to perform his assigned tasks to his best. During the early times, he was fondly called the "Lion Fine Master" because he was always able to fine the members in the most interesting way. He became President for the Rotary Year 1973-1974. It was during his term where many deserving students were granted scholarship grants. Furthermore, it was during his incumbency where the club extended valuable assistance for the Diocesan Adult Center. Pp Johnny has gifted half of his life to service and still gives a lot more. PP Johnny has, as a after of fact, been in Rotary service for forty nine (49) great years.



PP JACK GESNER

PP Jack Gesner entered Rotary Club of Baguio in September 8, 1966. PP. Jack Gesner was known during the early days as the "Best Tagalog Singer" in the club. He was the Vice President of PP Teop Rondez and become President in the year 1972-1973. He was called the "crisis president" because it was during his term where a big flood hit the country and worse, the declaration of Martial Law. Despite these challenges, he stood as a true Rotarian and pursued his adopted projects which included the reclamation of the City Camp Lagoon and the establishment of the Pre-School class at the Department of Social Welfare. He made sure of the continuation of the Pre-School class in Irisan. During his term, RCB sponsored Miss Jeannie Hamad as a Rotary exchange student to Naugatuck Conn USA. The Club then hosted an exchange student here, Miss Eve Ruttle from Ontorio Canada. Past President Jack Gesner has been in Rotary for forty three (43) challenging years.



PAST PRESIDENT TEOPISTO RONDEZ

Inducted as a Rotarian in January 13, 1968, PP Teops Rondez has become Club Secretary for Rotary Year 1969-1970. He was cited for efficiency by DG David "Dave" Sycip. He served as President for the Club for Rotary Year 1971-1972. Known today as the "Rotary Historian" of the Club, PP Teops continuously devotes his time to Rotary. He never fails to travel the extra mile enlightening the membership of the by-laws of the club whenever controversial issues are raised. In so doing, he always resolved matters the Rotary Way.



As a real trooper, PP Teops in one who can be relied on to accept any club assignment whether it be program participation, speakers' bureau or the tough job of drafting the amendments of the Rotary of Club of Baguio Constitution. PP Teops has been with Rotary for forty one (41) legal interpretation years.

PAST PRESIDENT MARCOS "BEN" CID

PP Ben Cid joined the Rotary Club of Baguio in January 11, 1969. He became the Club Secretary for Rotary Year 1971-1972. He was Club Treasurer for Rotary Year 1979-1980 and became President of the Club for Rotary Year 1982-1983. 




