Eyes of the World Literacy Project

The Eyes of the World is a project of RCB sponsored by our sister club, RC Bukit Bintang. It is a computer literacy project designed to tutor visually impaired children, specially in the areas where children have difficulty such as English, Math and Science.

On April 10 Dir. Naas was expecting 25 children for our computer training but to our surprise, 39 visually impaired children appeared from all over Northern Luzon.

On April 11, Dir Naas went to buy five extra laptops to have at least the minimum computers required and classes started the next day, April 12, with 39 blind and low vision children.

The children are lodged at the Tiptop facilities we rented, and food is prepared by our cook. Dir. Naas and I had to run to the commercial center to buy additional mattresses for them to sleep on. The eight youngest stay at Tiptop and two teachers are there for their tutorials while the others, travel to the Institute for Inclusive Education in Navy Base where they have their classes in three different rooms.

As the children are coming from the different provinces and have different learning needs the computer trainings are alternated with classes in English, Mathematics and Science which are the areas where the children have a lot of difficulties and are needed in connection with computer literacy. We have in two computer teachers, one math/science teacher and one English teacher.

Attached are some photos I took on April 10 at their arrival from different provinces of Northern Luzon, and on April 12 when they started to work with the computers available and on April 14 when all the schooling was in full swing.
















































